

Estimated Tuition, Fees, and Living Expenses for the 2010 - 2011 Academic Year

You must provide evidence of your ability to meet your expenses using **readily available liquid assets only** such as checking accounts, savings accounts, money market accounts, or certificates of deposit (time deposit) with maturity dates of less than one year. Investment portfolios of any kind, retirement plans, deeds to any real estate, leases with rental income, etc. are not acceptable evidence. If you will have an educational loan (Sallie Mae or Citi-Assist), provide the loan approval notice; we do not accept loan applications

If you are married and plan to bring your spouse or children, you must document additional funds for your dependents. The amounts for the 2010-2011 Academic Year are \$800 per month for your spouse and \$400 per month for each child. Your dependents may join you at any time during your program of study.

Summer tuition is required for certain programs in the Graduate School of Architecture Planning and Preservation, International and Public Affairs and Graduate Engineering
